Primary colors: red, blue and yellow

Secondary colors: green, violet and orange

How do you make an intermediate color: Mix a primary color with a secondary color

Color scheme: Plan for organizing colors

<u>Color</u>: Element of art that deals with reflected light.

Complementary colors: colors that are directly across from each other on the color wheel

Line: path of a dot moving through space.

<u>Scale</u>: The size relationship of one object to another.

Medium: material used to create an artwork

<u>Shape</u>: Element of art that is two dimensional, flat and enclosed in some way.

<u>Pattern</u>: Element of art that has visual repetition, must repeat <u>3</u> times to be a pattern.

Op Art: Artwork based on scientific knowledge to create optical illusions.

Non Objective Art: art that has no recognizable subject matter.

<u>Layout:</u> How items are arranged on the page.

<u>Balance:</u> Principle of art concerned with <u>equalizing</u> visual elements.

Mandala: An artwork that hads radial design, also means circle, center community.

<u>Radial Balance:</u> A type of balance that starts in the center and radiates outward.

<u>Horizon Line</u>: imaginary line where the earth and sky seem to meet.

<u>Perspective</u>: A graphic style of drawing that creates the illusion of 3 dimensions.
