Primary colors: red, blue and yellow

Secondary colors: green, violet and orange

How do you make an intermediate color: Mix a primary color with a secondary color

Color scheme: Plan for organizing colors

Color: Element of art that deals with reflected light.

Complementary colors: colors that are directly across from each other on the color wheel

Line: path of a dot moving through space.

Scale: The size relationship of one object to another.

Medium: material used to create an artwork

Shape: Element of art that is two dimensional, flat and enclosed in some way.

Pattern: Element of art that has visual repetition, must repeat **3** times to be a pattern.

Op Art: Artwork based on scientific knowledge to create optical illusions.

Non Objective Art: art that has no recognizable subject matter.

Layout: How items are arranged on the page.

Balance: Principle of art concerned with equalizing visual elements.

Mandala: An artwork that has radial design, also means circle, center community.

Radial Balance: A type of balance that starts in the center and radiates outward.

Horizon Line: imaginary line where the earth and sky seem to meet.

Perspective: A graphic style of drawing that creates the illusion of 3 dimensions.
